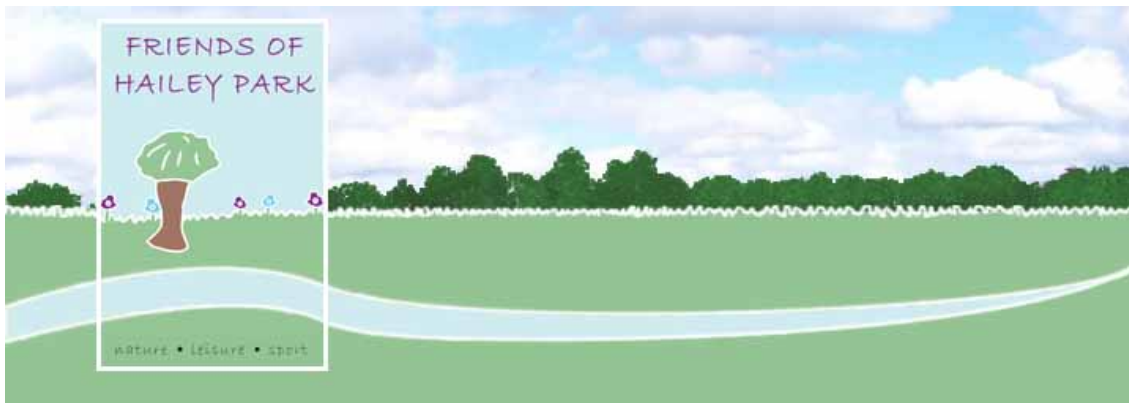

Tennis courts

The resurfacing and painting of the courts has now been completed. There are some fencing works outstanding as a result of supplier delays but these are due to be completed by the end of next week after which the contractor will be completing their reinstatement and the courts will be open to the public. We will keep you updated.

In regards to the remaining third of the courts, the money to work on this is dependent upon Section 106 funds becoming available from the sale of the BBC Llandaff Site, it will then be put to consultation as to what the community wish to see this portion of the courts used for – whether it would remain as tennis courts, in which case they'd be brought to the same standard as the rest of the courts or if there is a desire that it be turned into something else.

Llandaff North Traffic Consultation

Llandaff North is a very residential ward in the City of Cardiff, we're very fortunate to have a number of amenities such as parks, shops or the Cardiff Met Campus, either within the ward or close by that people wish to visit.

This puts pressure on our roads and our parking facilities—something that has repeatedly been raised with the Councillors. For the past few months, they have been working with Council Officers to bring forward a consultation that would enable residents in Llandaff North Ward to feedback what measures they would like to see put in place in order to best address these issues and, hopefully, create a safer environment for all who live here or wish to visit.

There are specific areas within the ward that experience very particular issues, through this consultation they aim to alleviate or directly address those concerns while not simply moving the problem elsewhere.

That's why they're looking at the ward as a whole and any ideas that are brought forward by residents will be considered on a wider basis rather than simply look at it street by street.
