Welsh Water planning application for Hailey Park pumping station

You may be aware that over the last year we have been carrying out investigatory work in Danescourt and Llandaff to help inform work that we are required to carry out on behalf of the Plasdŵr housing development near Radyr. We would like to provide you with an update on what this work involves, along with our plans to build a small pumping station within Hailey Park.

What are we doing?

To help manage the increased sewerage flow that we are expecting as a result of the Plasdŵr housing development, we're carrying out work to increase the capacity of the sewerage network and help reduce the risk of operational incidents for the wider community. This involves connecting the sewer pipe that runs from Danescourt to a connection point located on the other side of the River Taff. We are currently in the design and planning stages of this project, working closely with Cardiff Council, Transport for Wales and Natural Resources Wales.

Planning application for Hailey Park pumping station

Working closely with our designers and the local authority, it has been proposed that the best solution to manage the additional flows generated by this development will be to build a small pumping station within Hailey Park, to which the sewer pipe will connect and pump the sewerage to Cardiff Wastewater Treatment Works. The proposed location for the pumping station is by Ty Mawr Road, opposite the car park. We have recently shared our plans with both local councillors and the Friends of Hailey Park who we will continue to work with to ensure information is easily available to local residents.
