

There's a lot going on within Hailey Park over the next 1–2 years. An example of some of the projects fully supported by the Friends that also include their involvement:

- ❖ **"Pennies for Play"**: Application for grant funding at end of Jan 2012 to improve the children's play areas on the park – however, one stipulation is that we have to raise approx. £4000 within the community itself to get this grant. Any donations gratefully accepted (see Membership Form), however, small (its amazing how pennies can add up). FoHP have already donated £500 to this fund (therefore, £3500 left to find!).
- ❖ Try to negotiate a new building to replace the old, now sadly burnt-out, pavilion
- ❖ Rangers and volunteers improving the woodland & meadow areas through an active programme of management to increase biodiversity.
- ❖ Raising issues of responsible dog ownership within the park.
- ❖ Working with local schools, businesses, and community groups with educational projects and conservation work.
- ❖ Submission of the meadow area for a Green Pennant Award
- ❖ Continue to be actively involved in keeping park clean.
- ❖ New programme of public events for everyone.
